



Addition Worksheet - Build a 3 Digit Number

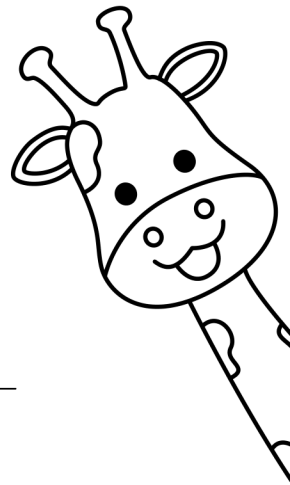
Use the parts to write the three digit number

Hundreds Tens Ones

Example: $100 + 10 + 7 = 117$

$400 + 30 + 9 = 439$

$$200 + 20 + 2 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$200 + 50 + 5 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$300 + 70 + 4 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$800 + 90 + 1 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

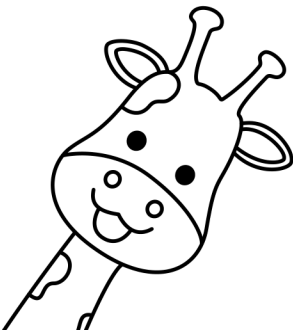
$$500 + 40 + 3 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$300 + 70 + 2 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$600 + 20 + 8 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$500 + 60 + 6 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$900 + 90 + 9 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$
